- The Applicant must be authorized, by their affiliated institution to represent the science being profiled and to accept the award

Submission

- Short bio and photo
- A 500-1,000 word written story or a 3-5 minute video story that discusses the following topics:
 - What are you working on and why is it important? How will your work impact people/society?
 - Who inspires you and/or what motivates you?
 - Why do you think it is important to tell stories of science?
